- You see each skater and can motivate and bring out their best, regardless of their level.
- You develop skaters through constructive feedback.
- You speak English or Norwegian, Swedish, or Danish.
- You adhere to the ethical guidelines of the Norwegian Skating Federation.

Your main tasks:

- Coach skaters both on and off ice, according to the club's schedule.
- Be the main responsible coach for one or more groups of skaters.
- Plan training sessions and coordinate your plans with other coaches sharing the ice.
- Work with the coaching team to plan the next season's schedule.
- Prepare skaters for competitions.
- Develop and adjust the skaters' programs.
- Travel and follow up skaters at competitions.
- Travel and follow up skaters at events and camps organized by the Norwegian Skating
 Federation
- Develop individually tailored plans to help the skaters improve and work towards their goals for the next season.
